After winning a finalist spot in the Nationwide Mercury Art Prize judged by Sir Peter Blake and White Cube's Tim Marlow, Steve Lazarides purchased work from Adam's graduate show, before commissioning and inviting him to participate in the gallery's group show. Adam has gone on to show at the Royal College, L. A, Japan and Palestine as well as throughout the UK. Adam lives and works in London.
